The 280 days (40 weeks) of the academic year represent – once Saturdays, Sundays, public holidays, school holidays and teacher-training days have been deducted – a total of about 178 working days. In order for the school to be able to provide the pupils with the knowledge and skills that society requires, teaching time must not be further reduced.

Foreign travel, skiing holidays, visits to family and friends, shopping trips, etc., should, as far as possible, take place during regular holidays.

### Leave of absence

By virtue of Chapter 7, Section 18, of the Swedish Education Act, a pupil enrolled in a type of school referred to in Section 17 may be granted a brief leave of absence for private business. If there are special reasons, a long leave of absence may be granted.

The principal of the school decides whether to grant a leave of absence.

### Catch-up study

The parents/legal guardians of a pupil granted extra leave of absence must be willing to help the pupil catch up with material that has been dealt with at school.

Remedial teaching to compensate for the loss of teaching time can be provided only to pupils who have been absent for other valid reasons, such as illness.
